First page:

1. Nasal cavity
2. Nose
3. Pharynx
4. Mouth
5. Epiglottis
6. Larynx
7. Trachea
8. Lung
9. Bronchi
10. Bronchioles
11. Alveoli
12. Diaphragm

Second Page:

1. They catch dirt and germs to keep them from passing into the lungs.
2. It travels through the throat, down into the trachea, into the bronchi and bronchioles to the alveoli.
3. They expand or move outward.
4. It contracts (or flattens).
5. It increases.
6. It passes through the walls (membranes) of the alveoli.
7. It closes.
8. It passes through the walls (membranes) of the alveoli.
9. It moves from the alveoli into the bronchioles, to the bronchi, trachea, and out through the mouth or nose.
10. They move inward.
11. It relaxes.
12. It increases.
